INSURANCE

The insurance coverage is as follows:

- Accident Injury/ Death – up to SGD 50,000
- Medical Expenses – up to SGD 2,500
- Third Party Liability – up to SGD \$1,000,000

The insurance **does not** cover:

- Travel cancellation
- Loss/damage to baggage and personal belongings
- Emergency evacuation

Delegates may purchase additional insurance coverage on their own.

PRE-CAMP PREPARATION

To enhance the cross-culture learning experience, it is important for overseas delegation to come prepared to showcase their nation's rich culture and heritage through traditional activities.

The delegations of each nation are required to prepare traditional activities that reflect the culture and heritage of their country.

Delegation should also prepare a 10 to 15 minutes presentation (in any format) to explain the cultural and heritage significance of the chosen activities.

Logistics is to be arranged by the delegation.
